The purpose of these emails (newsletters, as I call them) is to keep in contact with you and to let you know the plans for this year's country music festival. Here is a list of confirmed acts returning from last year: Sidekixx-NS, Steve Lyons-Reg Gallant and Yesterday's Wine-NB, Sonlight-NS, Yesterday-NS, and of course, Joyce Seamone & Total Country-NS. In addition to these acts, we have Dave Coggins & Bonded Stock-NS, Next Generation Seaboyer Band-Ontario, The Country Outlaws- NS, Matt Balsor and the Hilltop Showband-NS, as well as Ron Verge and Friends-NS. Darren Lively-NS, Shelly Joyce-NS, Myra Leblanc-NS, and Claudette Norman-NB, will be featured on Saturday afternoon backed by Total Country. The camping park offers plenty of wide open space to hold an outdoor festival along with lots of music, great sound, good food and happy people. Organizing a concert for profit requires an understanding of costs of booking performers, paying for sound, cost of food for the concession stands, power, water, advertising, accommodations, and the list goes on. In comparison with other festivals and events I think the owners offer a great four days of entertainment. After having said that, this is the first year that they have increased the cost of the country festival in many years. Advance tickets are \$70.00 per person prior to July 1/18. On July 1st, the cost goes to \$85.00 per person. Both prices includes tax. Pricing for individual days can be found at the website. Call me anytime to make your payments.

There may be people on this email list that have no idea that I do not live anywhere near the festival site but that I live over an hour away. To keep you up to date, I book the entertainment, look after scheduling the four days of entertainment, try and get sponsors, design the program that is given out at the gate upon your arrival and get it to the printer so it can be ready when you arrive. I look after radio advertising and also see that the posters for advertising are printed and distributed where ever we can get them out to the general public. My husband, Gerald, and I, enter many parades leading up to the festival to be visible and jog people's memories. I also look after site bookings, and ticket sales and confirmations. If you need your site confirmed from year to year, or have never been there before, contact me. Some people do call the office itself, but it makes it more convenient to call me and then Heidi

and I don't have so much back and forth to do over the phone. As for myself, during the four days of the festival, I have my own team of assistants who really shine and help me resolve issues on the spot that come up unexpectedly during the event. Nothing is ever perfect, and although it comes with its ups and downs, just when you think you have all the bases covered, along comes some new challenge to be met head on. It's what keeps me on my toes. ☺ But, when all is said and done and I look out at the line-up at the gate, or travel over the different fields and see all the people, see your smiles and hear your laughter, it's a good feeling. So a big thank you for being there and telling your friends and for your continued support.
